Charging port 2	Bluetooth headphones turn ON/OFF 1.Turn on: Long press the power button for 3 seconds, the blue light of the paring indicator will be on for a few seconds. 2.Turn off: Long Press the power button for 5 seconds. Bluetooth connection Follow the steps (Please make sure that your phone is built-in Bluetooth function) 1.Turn on the headphones, the paring indicator flashes alternately with blue and red, the headphone enter the pairing status. (Note: The headphones can automatically enter pairing status after power on if there is no re-connection. As the headphones can automatically reconnect with the last device that you had paired. To re-connect, you just need to turn it on.) 2. Activate the Bluetooth function and search for "HAVIT H630BT" referring to your phone instructions. 3. Manually click "HAVIT H630BT" to connect. Answer incoming calls Short press the power button to answer incoming calls. Tip: Since some mobile phones default to answer calls via their own receiver, please refer to the instructions of your phone and set on your phone. 3	End the current call Short press the power button to end the current call. Mode Switching Short press the mode button to switch mode(FM/TF card/Bluetooth) Reject incoming calls Press the power button for 2 seconds when there comes a call. Last number redial Double press the Power button to redial the last calling number. Voice assistant Double click the mode button to activate the voice assistant. Music playing 1.Play/Pause: Short press the Power button; 2.PREV: Long press - to select the previous song; 3.NEXT: Long press + to select the next song; 4.VOL + : Short press + to increase volume; 5.VOL - : Short press - to decrease volume. Wired mode: Dual 3.5mm Audio Cable 4
connecting To Audio Jack 1. Plug and play: Connecting the headphones to a music player with the provided dual 3.5mm audio cable, the headphones can be used as wired headphones without starting. 2. In this mode, you can't use any function of the headphones, including pause playback, volume adjustment, microphone and so on. TF card mode Insert a TF card and click the mode button, the headphones will recognize automatically to broadcast music. FM Operating Instructions 1.Short press the M button to choose FM mode; 2.Short press power switch to search channel; Long press - and + to select the desired channels. Short press the - or + button to adjust the volume. To charge the headphones 1.As product is built-in non-removable and rechargeable battery, please use the provided charging cable to charge. 2.Fully charge the product before the first use. It takes 2-3 hours to charge for the subsequent use. 5	3.The red light of the charging indicator is always on when charging, and the charging indicator turns blue when the battery is fully charged. Notes a. Please choose the charger that is certified by the regular manufacturer. - b.The battery performance may decrease as repeating charging and using the product. It's a normal phenomenon for all rechargeable batteries.
